Collective Worship

Safeguarding and Attendance

Safeguarding is always given the highest priority in school, and this includes the safeguarding of the children, staff and of our community. We have a DSL (Mrs. Patton) and two deputy DSLs- Mrs. Thorley and Mrs. Carey.

Sometimes families need help and support and the DSL team try and identify if this is the case and may refer the family (with their permission) for Early Help.

Any safeguarding concerns are passed on to the DSL team, who will then decide what to do next. If there is a concern that a child is not being kept safe in any way, then the DSL or Deputy DSL may refer this to Children's Services. Concerns may involve identification of neglect, a disclosure made by a child, changes in behavior, bruises or marks and concerns about online safety.

A lack of school attendance could be identified as a safeguarding concern and staff look out for patterns and reasons for absence for persistent absentees.
