
Children's books to support mental health and resilience


If you are looking for books to support your child with their mental health and resilience, we have some recommended reads for you. You can ask your local library to find you a copy of the book.

'The Magic Moment'- a little boy is too scared to go swimming and his Nan teaches him some mindfulness techniques to help him.







Wearing PE kit on PE days
